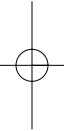


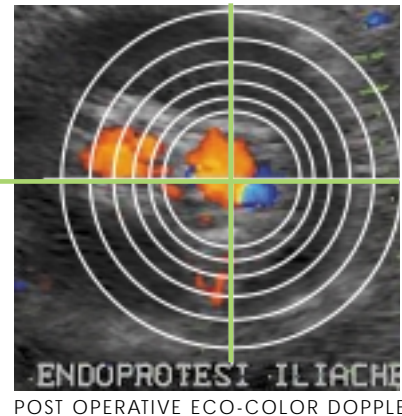

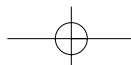

Dear Colleagues,

It has been a pleasure for me organizing the 3rd Congress "Monitoring in Vascular Surgery". After the second meeting many friends asked me to continue with this experience, so I accepted the responsibility of organizing a new edition, again in Bologna, my home city, on April 18-20, 2002. The Congress will take place in "Palazzo Re Enzo" built in 1246, the golden cage in which "Enzo", son of Frederick II and great grandson of Frederick I called Barbarossa, was imprisoned between 1249 and 1272, when he died. This palace is one of most beautiful historical buildings of medieval Bologna, situated in the main square of the city (Piazza Maggiore).

This upcoming Congress will have a format quite different from the previous ones, that is a full day dedicated to a European session: 12 Guest Lectures by Colleagues of world renown presenting the most advanced research in the field. In the same Session 12 Italian working group Co-ordinators will report the conclusions of their research on the most important topics of the Congress. The aim of these working groups is to validate the most common diagnostic tools and to lay the basis and define quality in Vascular Surgery and in Vascular Investigation.

Half of the Congress will be devoted to works-in-progress: the best 24 papers will be selected for presentation by the Scientific Committee. Special attention will be paid to posters, which are currently the most effective scientific communications. Posters will be discussed, and the best one will be commented by the Chairmen of the session. A prize will be awarded for the best poster and the best oral communication according to its originality, graphics or presentation.

Once again we have organized a parallel symposium for nurses who will debate their experience in operating or emergency rooms or in vascular laboratories; for this reason you are kindly requested to distribute the enclosed program to your nurses. All the congress sessions will be opened to nurses.

I have also devised a pleasant Social Program, which includes a Gala Dinner, a guided tour of the prestigious buildings and museums in the city and a evening in a typical osteria with plenty of wine, snacks and music.

I hope to welcome many of you in Bologna.

VENUE

Computerised slide center.

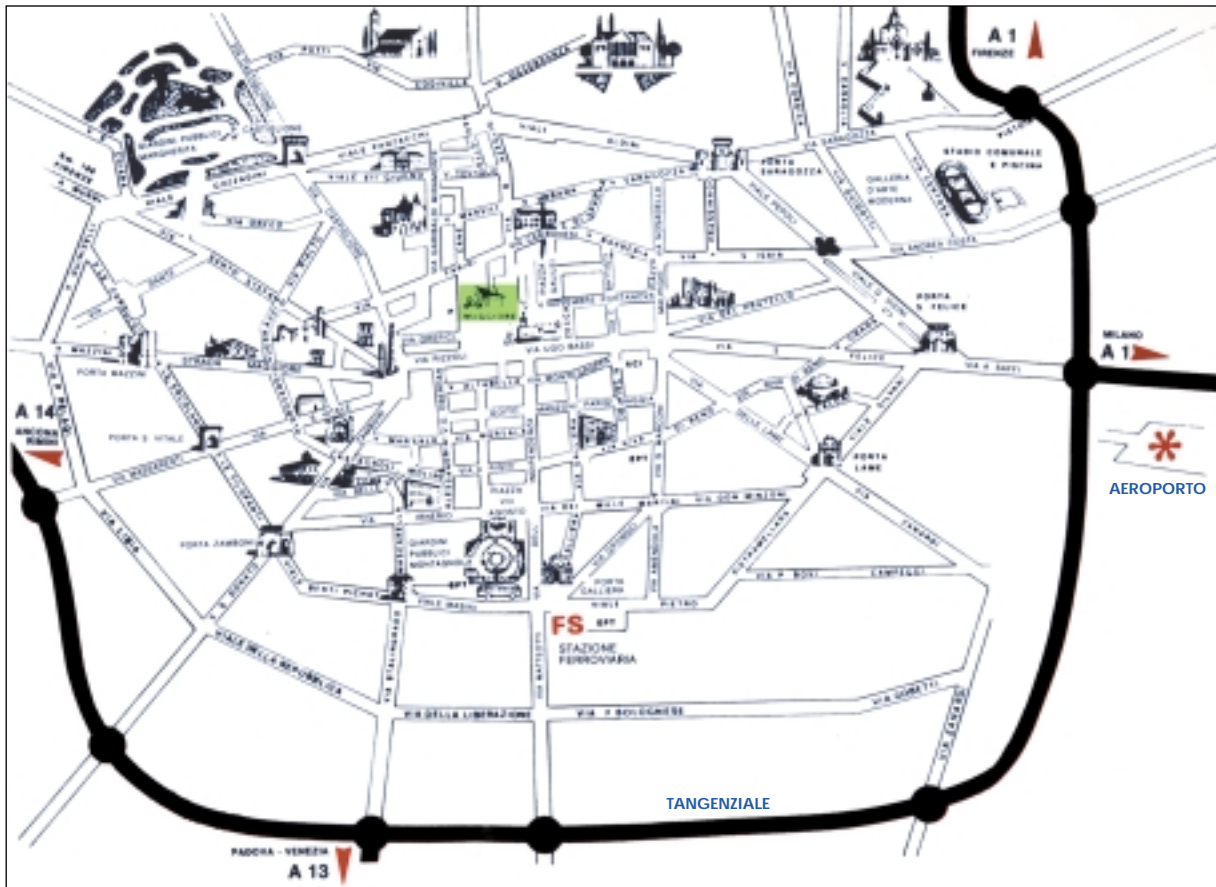

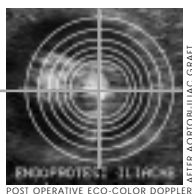
